Brightfelt to Receive Alumni Distinguished Service Award

Lincoln, Neb., April 10, 2009 – A founder of Dade Behring Inc. will be honored with the Nebraska Alumni Association's Distinguished Service Award during the All-University Celebration and Salute to Alumni Achievement at the Nebraska Champions Club May 8.

Robert W. Brightfelt of Lake Forest, Ill., retired as a group president of Dade Behring in 2002, after serving more than 36 years in the health care industry, including 29 years with the DuPont Co. He was a founder and member of the board of directors of Dade Behring, a \$1.8 billion global clinical diagnostics company which develops, manufactures, sells and services equipment and test reagents for more than 30,000 hospital laboratories. He continues to work part time as a consultant in the health care industry and as a member of the Chicago Architecture Foundation Auxiliary Board, chair of the Dean's Advisory Board of the UNL College of Engineering and a trustee of the University of Nebraska Foundation. Brightfelt received his bachelor's and master's degrees, with distinction, in mechanical engineering from UNL in 1965 and 1967.
